



PHOTOGRAPHY GUIDELINES



PLEASE DO NOT CROP YOUR IMAGE. It is better to have too much photo to work with than too little! We will work with you so your finished product exceeds your expectations. If you are scanning a photo, please adjust your scan settings to a minimum of 300 dpi. Do not compress files. Higher quality settings are best. Higher settings for cameras are also preferred.

Canvas Artwork

Remember, do not crop. Canvas Artwork usually requires our designers to carefully arrange your image to fit the canvas size, also allowing 1.5" on top and sides for the gallery wrap. The standard sizes offered will crop approximately the same amount of image on a standard 4"x6" photo (see image below left.) Due to the gallery wrap, we often need all of the height or width of the original photo.



For Canvas Artwork from 4"x6" print, red line denotes cropping and black line denotes surface edge of canvas, the image between the lines would be wrapped on the edge.



At your direction, our designers can also zoom in on one area of your image or change the orientation. We can isolate part of your image, erase blemishes (or people!) or add a border or text on your canvas for a nominal charge.

Tapestry Throws

Tapestry Throws will typically use more of the image, but how much is used varies depending on the size of the throw (see examples below.) Woven products like Tapestry Throws or Woven Pillows or Totes are a better choice for older or poorer quality images.



The images above represent the cropping from 4"x6" print, for 38"x52" on left and 52"x60" on right.

HD Fleece



Like Tapestry Throws, different HD Fleece sizes will use varying amounts of your image. Sample shows cropping for a 50"x60" fleece.

Woven Pillows Woven Totes



Woven Pillows and Woven Totes use square images.
